



The US Sciences-Po Alumni Association – 2009 Scholarship Program

The 2009 scholarships program granted by the US Sciences Po Alumni Association is structured to benefit outstanding students from colleges and universities in the United States interested to study at Sciences Po at an undergraduate, graduate or doctoral level.

The scholarships are opened, regardless of their citizenship, to all students in the [relevant programs](#).

US Sciences Po Alumni Association reserves the right to reduce or cancel any of the proposed scholarships in case none of the candidates' merits are considered outstanding. In 2008, three out of the four proposed scholarships were fully disbursed.

Calendar

The deadline for submission of all materials is **June 16th 2009**. Applications will be reviewed by qualified professionals and academics from the US Sciences Po Alumni Association and Sciences Po representatives.

The scholarship winners shall be announced by the end of July 2009 and granted as soon as Sciences Po confirms that the winners are enrolled for the 2009-2010 academic year.

Procedure (2 phases)

First phase: application materials (May-June 2009)

Each candidate application shall include:

- a resume;
- a statement of interest;
- two recommendation letters;
- a 2 pages essay on: "What is the value of a Sciences Po education for an American student?"

Second phase: interview by a panel (July 2009)

Shortlisted candidates will be interviewed by a panel that will meet in New York. All expenses (hotel, flight, one day per diem) incurred by the candidates will be reimbursed by the US Sciences Po Alumni Association.

Scholarship Structure (up to 3 scholarships)

PhD level (up to \$10,000)

1 scholarship for an outstanding doctoral student from a partner US University to study at Sciences Po at the PhD level

Master level (up to \$10,000)

1 scholarship for an outstanding student having graduated from a partner US University (or in the final year before graduation) to study at Sciences Po at the Master level; in particular:

- the BA/MA Programs (Columbia University, Johns Hopkins University)
- the JD/Master in Global Business Law (with the partner Law Schools, including Columbia Law School)
- the Master of International Affairs, the Master of Public Administration and the Master in Journalism (Columbia University)

Undergraduate level (2 scholarships of up to \$5.000 each)

2 scholarships for 2 outstanding undergraduate students in a partner US university to study for a year (or a semester) at Sciences Po
