

The following resolution was voted on and issued by the Columbia College Student Council yesterday evening (November, 10, 2002):

**RESOLUTION TO KEEP A DINING HALL OPEN DURING THE FALL & SPRING BREAKS**

WHEREAS, a sizable portion of the undergraduate student body stays on campus during fall and spring breaks.

WHEREAS, all of the undergraduate dining halls are closed during fall and spring breaks.

WHEREAS, many students find the cost of dining in New York City during the breaks to be expensive and, for some students, unaffordable.

BE IT RESOLVED, that Columbia College Student Council urges Dining Services to keep a dining hall that serves both lunch and dinner foods open during the fall and spring breaks to accommodate those students who stay on campus.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution is forwarded to the appropriate Dining Services administrators for immediate consideration.
