

The following was voted on and issued by the Columbia College Student Council yesterday evening:

Resolution to Include Students in the Decision Making Process for Changes to Alfred Lerner Hall

WHEREAS, Alfred Lerner Hall is the student center and an epicenter of student life and activities on the Columbia University campus.

WHEREAS, representatives from the undergraduate student councils have not been included in the decision-making process of spatial changes to our student center.

WHEREAS, the press and other groups have been notified of such proposed changes prior to the elected representatives of the undergraduate student body.

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee of Alfred Lerner Hall was created to be the body which considers all such changes.\*

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Columbia College Student Council recommends that the Executive Committee be immediately reconvened.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Columbia College Student Council requests that at least one Columbia College student, to be appointed by the council, be included on this committee.
