

The following resolution was voted on and issued by the Columbia College Student Council on December 7th, 2003:

RESOLUTION TO EXTEND HOURS OF RESIDENTIAL MUSIC PRACTICE ROOMS

WHEREAS, at present, the residential music practice rooms are locked after midnight;

WHEREAS, the residential music practice rooms are soundproof, and therefore, would not disturb other residents;

WHEREAS, for some Columbia students, the early morning hours are the only time available in their schedules to practice music;

BE IT RESOLVED, that Columbia College Student Council urges the Division of Housing and Dining to keep the residential music practice rooms open twenty-four hours a day.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution is forwarded to the appropriate Housing administrators for immediate consideration.
