Ashok Maliakal, PhD Research Scientist, Bell Laboratories

Do you want to apply the skills you learned during your Ph.D. to solving relevant problems? Learn about being a Research Scientist at Bell Labs. Dr. Maliakal will discuss the path to his current position, what he does as a scientist at Bell Labs, and what you should do to obtain a position like his.

Dr. Maliakal is a member of the technical staff at Bell Laboratories in Murray Hill, NJ. He was recently named one of Technology Review magazine's TR35, a list of the top 35 innovators in the world under the age of 35. Dr. Maliakal holds a bachelor's degree in Chemistry from Cornell University and a Ph.D. in organic chemistry from Columbia University (with Professor Turro). He joined Bell Labs as a post-doctoral fellow in 2003 and became a full-time researcher in 2005.
