Conservation Biology Scholarship Application, 2008-09

The Department of Ecology, Evolution, and Environmental Biology (E3B) and the Center for Environmental Research and Conservation (CERC) invite applicants to the Conservation Biology Master's Program in E3B to apply for the scholarship position(s) of course assistant for the Certificate Program in Conservation Biology.

The Certificate in Conservation Biology, administered by CERC, is designed to bring conservation science knowledge to professionals in both the public and the private sectors. The program is delivered during the academic year in five-week modules. Classes are held during the evenings only, Monday through Thursday from 6-8 pm. This certificate program fulfills one of the core missions of CERC – that of building environmental leadership.

Students awarded a course assistantship will help faculty prepare for classes, attend all class meetings, answer student questions, and carry out other responsibilities as these arise. Students work up to 10 hours a week.

Course assistants will receive a combination of partial tuition and a stipend up to \$1800 per academic year. The scholarship is renewable for the second year of the Conservation Biology Master's Program.

You must be admitted into the E3B Masters in Conservation Biology program to be eligible for the scholarship.
