Whereas the students that we represent will suffer directly as a result of the graduate students' absence from our community and classrooms;

Whereas these students' grades, educations, and, most importantly, futures will depend on the successful and normalized completion of the semester; therefore be it,

Whereas ALL members of our community ought to have an adequate voice on issues that affect it;

Resolved that we urge the Columbia University Administration and the students on strike do everything within their power to bring the strike to a fair and timely conclusion.
