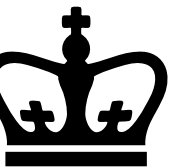

## Greetings from the President

Dear members and friends of KGSA,

It was my great honor to serve you as the 44th president at the Korean Graduate Students Association at Columbia University. Columbia KGSA has the longest history of serving Korean students amongst any Ivy League schools. We have over 700 Korean students participating. During a recent few years, Columbia KGSA had a momentum to establish stronger organizational structures and valuable programs. I often heard that Columbia KGSA has been referred as a model of successful student organization.

There are a few things I emphasized to a KGSA executive board during my term. We aimed to provide practical support to Korean students in Columbia University, and to promote excellence of Korean culture in New York City. At the 104th Korea Forum "Korean, New York, Now", three inspirational speakers showed current state of Korean working professionals in New York City, and encouraged students in their career path after graduation. Through several information sessions held with legal experts, we provided answers to students' common issues such as working visa and immigration.

We also supported dozens of recruiting session of Korean and International companies, who desired to hire talented Korean students from Columbia University. From the 2010 World Cup viewing party where two hundred people gathered, to the Spring Mixer with New York University KGSA, many networking and socializing event were offered to the students. Our Annual Christmas Charity event, which was our third time organizing last year, became one of the most awaited and popular party in town and more than 900 guests were attended. Part of the profit from this party was donated to Korean American Family Service Center, a nonprofit organization for anti-domestic violence.

Furthermore, I understood that one of the challenges KGSA faced was the lack of engagement with non-Koreans and students from other universities. Therefore, it was my goal to lead this association as the young generation of Koreans to promote the excellence in both Korean legacy and contemporary culture in the city of New York. At the 105th Korea Forum "A Living History" where Ms. Hae-gyeong Yi shared her story as a princess of Korea's last dynasty, Joseon, many non-Korean students and professors in Columbia University attended the event to listen to unfiltered history. Also, numerous students volunteered for events in Korean community such as Korean Parade, and the 51th Korean Night Gala held by Korean American Association of Greater New York.

I want to thank each and every one of KGSA members who has participated by volunteering or attending our events. Also, I appreciate Columbia University Alumni Association in Korea, KAAGNY, and corporate sponsors who supported our events. Last but not least, I thank executive board members. It was my biggest pleasure to work with passionate and brilliant directors. Despite the hectic academic schedule, those directors performed enthusiastically with a high level of professionalism. Without KGSA members' participation and executive board members dedication, nothing would have been possible. Thank you again and good luck with your study and new life after graduation!

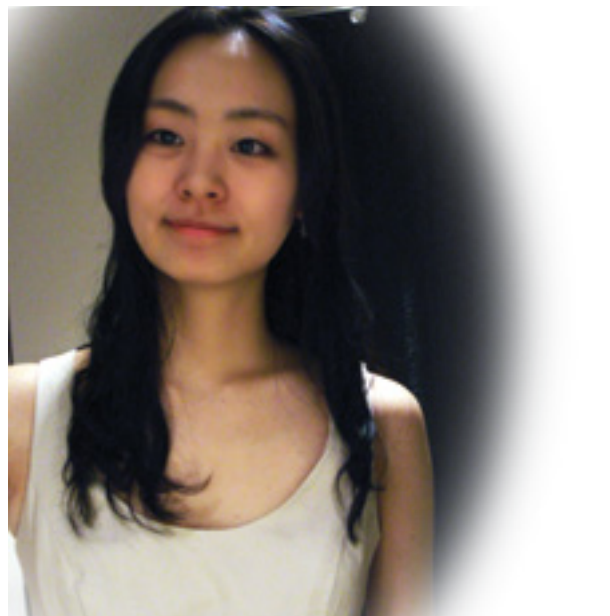

We heard that the princess from the last Korean dynasty lives in NYC and thought that inviting her would give an insight story to our history, so that we can find out what really happened. She generously accepted our invitation and came to communicate with the students who are so interested in the history of Korea. The Q&A session was so passionate with the enthusiasm to learn more about our history better. Along with many Korean students, students from different culture came to hear this unfiltered history.

### 휴면 & 休

#### 사람과 사람 옛 프린세스의 극절 많은 삶

"나는 프린세스가 아닙니다. 왕조는 오래 전에 끝났습니다." 고종과 귀인 장씨 사이에 태어난 의친왕의 딸로, 현재 미국 뉴욕에 살고 있는 이해경여사(82)는 2월 18일 컬럼비아 대학 한국학생회가 주최한 강연회에 나타나 이렇게 말했다. 이 여사는 "왕족이었지만" 내 인생은 처음부터 혼란스러웠다"라고 말했다. 아버지는 고독했고 그녀가 특별한 경우에만 볼 수 있었다. 게다가 모친은 불미스러운 일로 궁에서 쫓겨나 열세 살 이후에는 얼굴조차 볼 수 없었다. 1945년 광복은 그녀와 왕족들에게도 엄청난 변화를 일으켰다. 난생처음 생계를 위해 국을 일해야 했다. 그 즈음 부친의 뜻에 따



라 약혼을 했지만 이 여사는 결혼하지 않았다. 그 와중에 한국전쟁이 터졌다. 부산으로 피란한 그녀는 우연히 미군 사령부에서 사서로 일하다가, 한 미군과 교회의 도움으로 1956년 텍사스로 유학했다. 가족과 과거로부터 도피하고 싶었다. 그래서 무조건 한국을 떠났고 이후 한동안 가족에게 주소도 알리지 않았다"라고 이 여사는 회고했다. 1960년 말, 그녀는 컬럼비아 대학 동양학 도서관 사서로 들어갔다. 그리고 그곳에서 몸나는 대로 한국 역사책을 읽으며 자신의 정체성을 잃지 않으려 애썼다. 책 속에서 조국을 발견하고 기쁨에 젖은 일도 있었다. 1996년 컬럼비아 대학에서 퇴직한 이 여사는 요즘 대학 부근에서 혼자 살고 있다. 여든들의 나이 어찌면 마지막 공식 석상이 될지도 모를 '프린세스'의 외출에 청중은 뜨거운 박수갈채를 아끼지 않았다. 뉴욕이나온(컬럼비아 대학 한국학생회)인
