Resolution to Provide a Refrigerator for Student Use

SPONSOR Brittany J. Schoepp

WHEREAS students have repeatedly expressed a desire for refrigerator access;

A refrigerator will save students money and accommodate students with dietary restrictions, and

5 Columbia Law School has agreed to pay for weekly cleaning of a refrigerator.

RESOLVED BY THE COLUMBIA LAW SCHOOL STUDENT SENATE that the Senate will purchase a refrigerator as soon as possible;

That the refrigerator will be installed in the basement of William and June Warren Hall;

That the refrigerator will be clearly labeled with a sign indicating that,

- (i) All items remaining inside the refrigerator at the end of each week will be removed upon cleaning;
 - (ii) Items not clearly labeled with the owner's name may be removed earlier; and
 - (iii) Neither the Law School nor the Student Senate are responsible for items left inside the refrigerator.

- (iv) This refrigerator is property of the students of Columbia Law School, and was purchased by the Columbia Law School Student Senate with funds from the Student Activity Fee.

That the Student Senate President shall transmit a copy of this resolution, with the Senate's endorsement, to the Dean of Students and Director of Building Services and Operations.
