5 WHEREAS guaranteed core funding reduces the Budget Committee's flexibility, complicates the Recognition Committee's decision-making process, and burdens aspiring student groups without providing significant benefits to existing student groups not already available through the usual budget allocation process.

RESOLVED BY THE COLUMBIA LAW SCHOOL STUDENT SENATE,

That the 2010–11 Treasurer and Student Senate be urged to replace core funding with a need-based method of allocating funds, and

10 That the Student Senate Treasurer transmit this suggestion, with the 2009–10 Senate's endorsement, to the 2010–11 Executive Board.
