DESCRIPTION:

Correspondence, manuscripts, notebooks, and publications of Henri-Martin Barzun (1881-1973), author, editor, and professor of French literature. A large number of manuscripts, reflecting Barzun's varied interests in poetry, literature, and political affairs, are in the collection. There are also some materials for Art et Action, which Barzun helped to found; lecture notes, 1933-1952; and a few items pertaining to Filippo Tommaso Marinetti and the Futurists. The correspondence is primarily from French and American authors and includes letters written by André Breton, Katherine Dreier, Marcel Duchamp, Georges Duhamel, Albert Gleizes, Ivan Goll, Harriet Monroe, Ezra Pound, Pierre Reverdy, Edgar Varèse, Gabriel d'Annunzio, and Filippo Tommaso Marinetti, and some Barzun family papers.

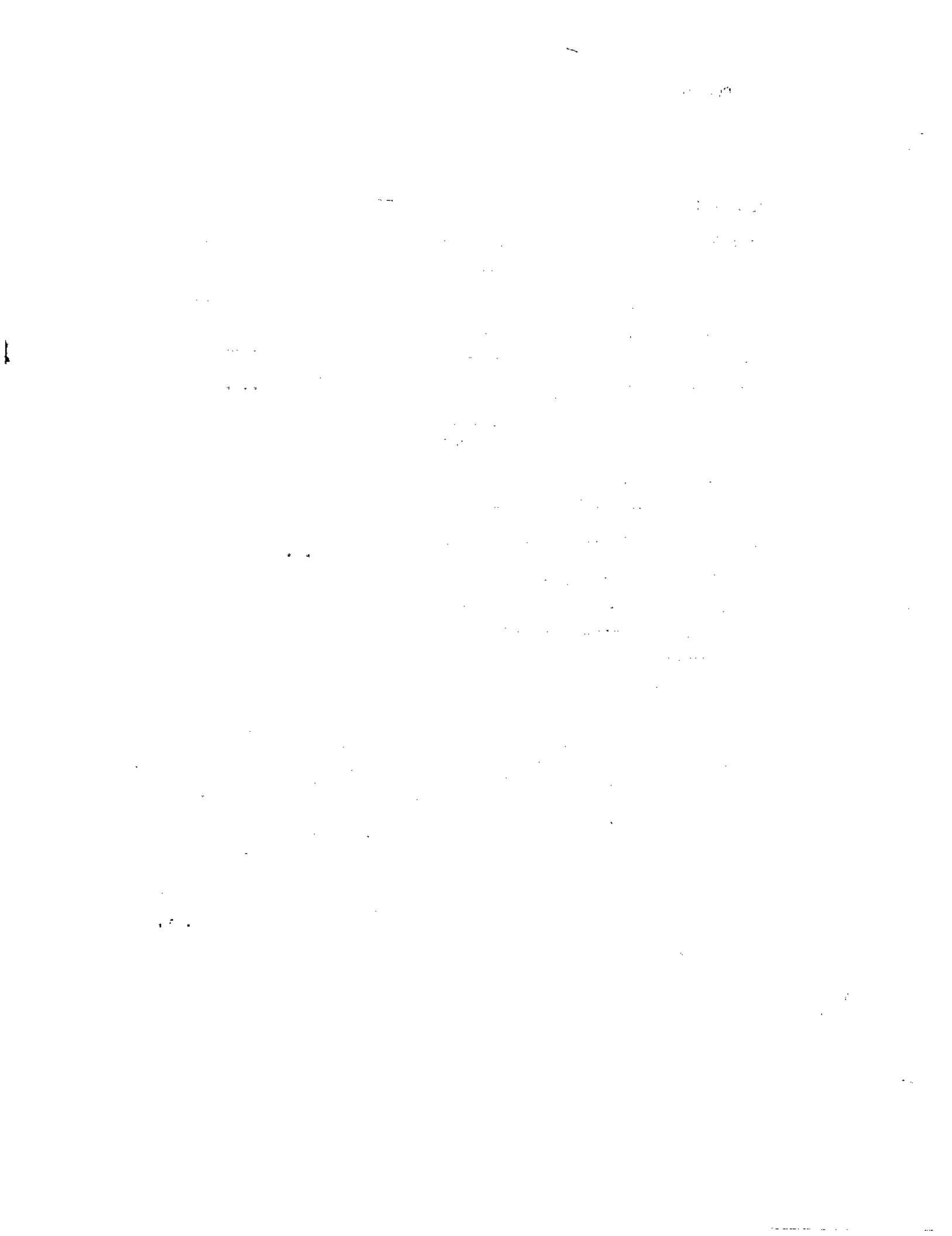
