

**Cable, George Washington, 1844-1925.**

Papers, 1882-1970.

3.5 linear ft (ca.2,700 items in 8 boxes & 1 board portfolio).

**Biography:** American novelist.

**Summary:** Correspondence, manuscripts, documents, photographs, and printed material. Most of the correspondence is from Cable to Adelene Moffat and relates to the Home Culture Clubs. Other correspondents include Louise S. Cable and Adelene Moffat. There are also typescript and handwritten drafts by Cable; manuscripts, documents, and printed matter concerning Moffat's work with the Home Culture Clubs; photostatic copies of correspondence and manuscripts concerning Cable from other libraries; transcriptions of the correspondence between Cable and Moffat; a transcription of the journal of Clarence B. Roote, an acquaintance of Cable and Moffat; and one box of manuscripts, notes, and related items concerning Philip Butcher's book about the correspondence between Cable and Moffat, *So Full a Harmony*.

**Organization:** Selected items cataloged; remainder arranged. Box 1-2: Cataloged correspondence; Box 3: Cataloged manuscripts, documents, & photographs; Box 4: Arranged material & transcriptions of letters; Box 5: Transcriptions; Box 6: Transcriptions & printed material; Box 7: Printed material; Box 8: Butcher, *So Full a Harmony*; Oversize: Home Culture Clubs registers.

Cataloged correspondence (Boxes 1 and 2) is on microfilm.

The Adelene Moffat diary on the Home-Culture Clubs (which also contains letters to her from Cable) and her Diary/Notebook, 1927-36, are on microfilm.

"Attalic Brouillard" (a.ms., 16p.) and "Dr. Sevier" (a.ms., 53p.) are on microfilm.
