DESCRIPTION:

Photograph albums containing photos of Thomas and Jane Welsh Carlyle, their house at Cheyne Row, members of their families, and their friends in the literary and political worlds. Six of the volumes bear the notes and annotations of Thomas Carlyle. In addition, there is a small group of Thomas Carlyle autographs. There is also a seventh photograph album bearing the annotations of Carlyle's nephew, Alexander Carlyle.

Also included are copies of 33 photographs received as an exchange with the library of the University of Edinburgh, 8 April 1974. (Not on film.)
