DESCRIPTION:

Twenty four volumes of the public papers and letterbooks of De Witt Clinton. Volumes 1 - 15 contain letters written to De Witt Clinton 1785 -1828. They are mounted with an average of 65 letters to a volume, or approximately 975 in all. Volumes 16-23 are letter-books covering the years 1793 - 1828 and average 300 pages to the volume. Volume 24 contains miscellaneous papers, speeches, poems and the like in various hands.
