DESCRIPTION:

The collection contains letters written by the noted wood engraver Timothy Cole to Robert Underwood Johnson. These letters cover the period Cole was in Europe making engravings of great European paintings for a series which appeared in Johnson's Century magazine.

There are also letters from Cole to Melvin Loos. These relate to the printing of Cole's engravings of paintings and portraits.

Also included in the collection are 250 engravings by Cole.
