RESTRICTIONS ON USE

DESCRIPTION A collection of artifacts gathered by Dr. Henry Nehemiah Dodge, 1843-1937, (Columbia M.D., 1868) while traveling with Columbia professor Henry Drisler during 1859 and 1860. The majority of the items are souvenirs from Roman and Pompeian ruins, such as a fragment from the ruins of Vespasian's Temple in Rome, and a piece of a wine jar found in Pompeii. Several other American and European curios are also included. For a journal of Dodge's travels, see Columbian Ms. No. 141.

is covered with a thin layer of white earth or pebbles. The whole  
was found in the ruins of a villa, probably an eruption of  
the volcano Mount Vesuvius.

26. Fragments of glass, broken and stained with colors. Found in the subsoil of St. Lucina, in  
the district of Naples.

28. Fragments of glass at Roman glass works. From Hadrian's villa near Tivoli.

29. Fragments of glass, broken and stained with colors, containing a shell. From Tivoli  
near Rome.

30. A piece of colored sculptured marble from the ruins of Hadrian's villa  
near Tivoli.

31. Fragments of glass, with the ruins of the villa of Augustus. Such lamps were  
placed in the graves of the dead.

32. Piece of glass, with the ruins of the villa of Augustus. Found in the ruins of Hadrian's villa,  
Tivoli, near Rome. (See also No. 29, above).

33. Glass vessel, broken and stained with colors. Found in the Forest at Perugia.

34. A piece of glass.

35. A piece of glass, with the ruins of the villa of Pompeii IX and  
XII, near Pompeii, Italy. (See also Nos. 29 and 30, above).

36. A piece of glass.

11. A fragment of a sword, called "Bogard" or "Wingard". Taken from a  
grave at Tivoli.

12. A small silver ring with a jewel in the shape of a lion, Rome.

13. A small fragment of a ring found on the slopes of Mount Vettore, near Tivoli and  
Viterbo, Italy.

14. A fragment of a small rope-like cable laid between Ireland and  
England, about 1800.

15. A fragment of a small vessel.

16. A fragment of a small vessel.

17. A fragment of a small vessel of a thin wine jar which a man broke off  
near the top, and part of the handle of another in Pompeii.

18. Piece of stone called "St. Paul" out of which the catacombs of St. Lucina,  
Rome, were hewn. This is known from an old grave there Four stories  
below the ground.

19. Fragments from Cumberland, England.

20. United whitewings.

21. A calcareous cylinder from the crater of Vesuvius.

22. Stone composed of powdered rocks, etc. From the temple of Neptune,  
at Pozzuoli, south of Naples.

23. Piece of the living rock in the "Mangerino" prison, Rome; where Inguetha  
was imprisoned and according to legend St. Paul also.

24. A specimen of the stone from which salt is extracted in the salt mines of  
Sax, in Sicily Island.

25. Marble from near Verona.

26. Specimen of purple soap iron "Nobes' children"

27. A fragment of a carbuncle known as the heart of the battle of the  
soldiers, found on a field (June 1863) on the field of Magenta,  
Italy, where the soldiers were fought the year before by  
the French.

28. Many fine fragments of human skeleton. Near Tivoli near Rome.

29. Fragments from the ruins of the "Colosseum", Rome.

30. A fragment of the column in the ruins of Colchester, England.

13. A small white bird - Alouatta.
14. Black and white bird with long tail - Macacus.
15. Small bird - like a sparrow, but with the form of  
Heron - Accipiter, Accipitridae, Italy.
16. A very small bird - Alouatta - Island of Capri in the  
Mediterranean Sea - Italy.
17. Small bird - Accipiter - name of the Accipitridae family - Italy.
18. Large bird - Accipiter - Italy - Accipitridae (Chirillobin).
