Also included is a manuscript notebook containing at least 55 readily identifiable pieces (articles, talks, and book reviews) mostly with titles. These are carefully corrected first drafts. They include a long essay on Grave's "White Goddess", an introduction to Edgell Rickword, and essays on J.R. Ackerley, Ruth Pitter, "My Kind of Poetry", "Auden at Sixty", George Orwell, A.E. Housman, F.R. Leavis, etc.
