 Material relating to the inventor, Robert Fulton (1765-1815) within a period 1809 to 1815. There are two letters, three deeds and eight other items classifying as legal or business papers, dealing chiefly with lands and matters concerning Fulton's steamboats. There is also an unidentified photograph and three letters (1828-30) written to Walter Edwards, a lawyer living in New York by his father and two brothers, but having no clear reference to or connection with Fulton.
