DESCRIPTION: Correspondence, manuscripts, drawings, watercolors, sketches, proofs, and printed materials of Tibor Gergely (1900-1978), the Hungarian-born painer and illustrator who came to New York in 1939, best known in this country for his work on the popular Golden Book series for children. The collection includes original watercolor, pen-and-ink and pencil illustrations for fifty books by various authors, beginning with Georges Duplaix's Topsy Turvy Circus (1940), and continuing with Golden Book's Scuffy the Tugboat and Tootles the Train by Gertrude Crampton; Duplaix's The Merry Shipwreck; Kipling's The Jungle Books, and the artist's dummy for The Wheel on the Chimney by Margaret Wise Brown, a Caldecott Honor book. Also included are illustrations for nineteen books by Tibor Gergely; advertising and commercial art of the 1940s, political cartoons and caricatures from the 1930s and 1940s in Europe and America; designs for greeting cards, posters, and record Jackets; and eighteen watercolor drawings for New Yorker covers, many of

which were published in the 1940s. A selection of manuscripts, correspondence,

Tibor Gergely (1900-1978), the Hungarian-born painter and illustrator who came to New York in 1939, is perhaps best known in this country for his work on the popular Golden Book series for children. The collection includes illustrations for fifty books by various authors, beginning with Georges Duplaix's Topsy turvy circus (1940), and ending with Annemarie von Hill's Mein grosses Vogel-Lexicon (1977). Included in the collection are illustrations for Golden's Scuffy the tugboat and Tootles the train, by Gertrude Crampton, Duplaix's The merry shipwreck, and Kipling's The jungle books, as well as the artist's dummy for The wheel on the chimney, by Margaret Wise Brown, a Caldecott Honor book. Also included are illustrations for nineteen books by Tibor Gergely, most notably Busy day, busy people, 500 Animals from A to Z, and Gergely's great big book of bedtime stories.

Every aspect of Gergely's diverse career is represented in the collection, including advertising and commercial art of the 1940s, political cartoons and caricatures done in Europe and the United States in the 1930s and 1940s, and designs for greeting cards, posters and record jackets. Gergely's magazine illustrations are also represented, most important among which are the eighteen watercolor drawings for New Yorker covers. These designs, many of which were published, date from the mid- to late-1940s, and capture that period with Gergely's unique charm and wit. A selection of manuscripts, correspondence, printed material and miscellaneous art work is also included in the collection.
