Correspondence, notes, manuscripts, and diaries of Carter Goodrich(1897-1971), professor emeritus of economics at Columbia University. Goodrich, one of America's foremost economic historians, served as chairman of the governing body of the International Labor Office, 1939-15, as chief of the UN economic survey mission in Vietnam, 1955-56, and as special representative to Bolivia for the Secretary General of the UN, 1952-53. His diaries and interviews in 1911 when he was assistant to the Ambassador to Great Britain provide interesting insights into economic problems of the early part of World War II. The file for the International Labor Office is also quite informative and contains correspondence from many prominent economists, Herbert Lehman, Isidor Lubin, and Frances Perkins.
