Parts of Hoffman's papers have already been deposited at Tulane University and at the University of Pennsylvania.

Most of the items are of a personal nature, but there is substantial information about her involvement with the United Daughters of the Confederacy. Also included are correspondence, notes, manuscripts, and printed matter of Ella Hoffman Rigney, daughter of F.L. Hoffman and director of the Raphael House in San Francisco.
