DESCRIPTION: Some miscellaneous papers of John Thompson Hoffman, 1828-1888, Tammany politician, Mayor of New York City, 1865-1868 and governor of New York State, 1869-1871. With the exception of a dozen miscellaneous letters and documents of a routine nature, the collection consists of four scrapbooks of newspaper clippings from a variety of New York City and State newspapers and some memorabilia relating to Hoffman's political life. One facsimile of a Hoffman letter and an autographed visiting card of Horatio C. King have been cataloged.
