DESCRIPTION:

Correspondence, manuscripts and notes of Richard Hofstadter (1916-1970; M.A., 1938; Ph.D., 1942) DeWitt Clinton Professor of American History at Columbia. Hofstadter authored numerous important books and articles relating to American history, this collection contains his manuscripts for most of them. In addition, there are copies of many of his book reviews, plus articles by other authors, analyzing the impact of his interpretations of American history. The correspondence includes letters from and to Henry Steele Commager, C. Vann Woodward, Stuart Bruchey, Samuel Eliot Morison, and Clarence Ver Steeg, Alfred A. Knopf, Helen Frankenthaler, Arthur M. Schlesinger, Jr., and others. Included in the collection are two manuscripts for Anti-intellectualism in America Life & The Paranoid Style in American Politics which Professor Hofstadter presented to Special Collections in 1963 & 1966.
