Biography: Holmes was an essayist, poet, lecturer, Dean of the Harvard Medical School, and leader in the Unitarian movement.

Summary: Letters of Oliver Wendell Holmes, Sr. from various sources. Among his correspondents are James T. Field, Howard Pyle, and Benjamin H. Ticknor. There are also two Holmes manuscripts: an epigram and six lines from one of his poems.
