Frank Baum publishes The Baum Bugle and other occasional publications about Oz, sponsors conventions, and exchanges want lists among its members. Among the correspondence received by Schiller, there are many letters from Fred Meyer, officer of the club, Dick Martin, an Oz illustrator, Ruth Plumly Thompson, author of many later Oz stories, and several members of the Baum family.
