DESCRIPTION:  
The correspondence, manuscripts, memoranda, awards, photographs, clippings, and other printed materials of Marion Edwena Kenworthy, 1891-1980 (Tufts University MD 1913; Columbia University ScD 1973), analyst and professor of Psychiatry at the Columbia University School of Social Work (The New York School of Social Work) from 1921 to 1956, deal mostly with Dr Kenworthy's academic career, her work as a consultant especially as a member of the National Civilian Advisory Commission of the Women's Army Corps during World War II, and the endowment of a Professorial Chair of Psychiatry in her name at the Columbia University School of Social Work in 1956. Among the cataloged correspondents are: Dwight D. Eisenhower, Herbert H. Lehman, Karl A. Menninger, and Eleanor Roosevelt.
