## DESCRIPTION:

Correspondence, manuscripts, documents, clippings, and printed materials of Ferdinand Kuhn, 1905-1978 (Columbia University A.B. 1925), journalist and author on foreign affairs. Ferdinand Kuhn was a foreign correspondent for the New York Times from 1925 until 1940, with the Office of War Information from 1941 until 1945, diplomatic correspondent for The Washington Post from 1946 until 1953, and a freelance reporter from 1953 until 1978. In much of his writing he collaborated with his wife, Delia Wolf Kuhn. These files deal with his published books, book reviews, editorials, lecture notes, magazine and newspaper stories, and teaching materials.
