DESCRIPTION:

Letters of E. V. Lucas (1868-1938) to Arnold Bennett. Lucas, essayist and publisher, was a director of Methuen & Company, which brought out many of Bennett's books. The letters discuss details of publishing, and contain many personal references as well. Included are twenty carbon copies and one draft original of Bennett's replies.
