The correspondence deals chiefly with the period when she was editor of The Delineator, 1920-1926, the Sunday Magazine of the New York Herald Tribune, 1926-1943, and This Week Magazine, 1934-1943. The letters cover a wide field of interest and include correspondence from cabinet ministers, diplomats, jurists, authors, journalists, editors, educators, soldiers, and socialites.
