## DESCRIPTION:

A group of letters and manuscripts of Christopher Morley (1890-1957). Eleven of these items were transferred from General Manuscript Collection at the time that the remainder were placed on deposit by Barnard Library. The five letters are to various persons. Among the manuscripts are an early poem, "The Flags on Fifth Avenue" (1916); an essay entitled "In the Steerage of the Lusitania;" a one-act play entitled "On the Shelf;" and a 1941 revision of Shakespeare's Tempest.
