DESCRIPTION: Letters, invitations, documents, page proofs, photographs, lithographs and books of Judge Samuel Irving Rosenman (1896-1973; A.B., 1915; LL.B., 1918) a justice of the New York Supreme Court and a special counsel to President Franklin D. Roosevelt. Included are 8 letters from political acquaintances to Rosenman and his wife Dorothy, among them two each from Benjamin Cardozo and W. Averell Harriman, 1 letter by Henry Clay, approximately 50 invitations to official social functions, 2 sets of proofs for political pamphlets written by Rosenman on behalf of New York Governor Alfred E. Smith, 12 photographic and 3 lithographic portraits of political acquaintances signed and inscribed to him, including Dwight D. Eisenhower, W. Averell Harriman, Franklin D. Roosevelt, and Harry S. Truman. There are also 13 books dealing with the Roosevelt administration signed and inscribed by the authors.
