

**Samuels, Jack Harris, d. 1966, collector.**

English and American literary manuscripts and letters collection, 1663-1964.

**Biography:** Samuels (Columbia University A.M., 1940, in English Literature) was born January 22nd, 1915 and died the 29th of September, 1966.

**Summary:** A collection of letters, manuscripts, proofs, and drawings of English and American authors, including 33 letters from Alan Gabriel Barnsley (Gabriel Fielding) to Derek Stanford; a letter from James Boswell to George Colman the younger; 5 letters from Gamaliel Bradford (1863-1932) to J.L. Bradley; a letter from Wilkie Collins; a letter from James Fenimore Cooper to William Buell Sprague; a letter from Dinah Maria Mulock Craik; letters from E.M. Forster; letters from Sarah Grand to James B. Pond; letters from H. Rider Haggard; a letter from Vachel Lindsay to H.B. Fuller; letters from T.B. Macauley; a letter from Hester Lynch Piozzi to James Robson; a letter from Jane Porter to Charles Denham; 13 letters from W.H. Mallock to Swan Sonnenschein & Co.; letters and cards from G.B. Shaw; letters from R.B. Sheridan to Thomas Grenville and to C. Ward, and a letter from Elizabeth Ann Linley Sheridan to R.B. Sheridan; a letter from W.M. Thackeray to Mr Payne; letters from Anthony Trollope written to Frederic Chapman, Mary Christie, J.T. Fields, Frederic Harrison, and others; a letter from William Wordsworth to F.W. Faber; a letter from Charlotte Yonge to her cousin Fanny; a letter to Alfred, Lord Tennyson to Benjamin Disraeli; letters from Rhoda Broughton and Ellen Terry; and postcards from Evelyn Waugh to Graham Ackroyd.

The manuscripts include examples by Max Beerbohm, Arnold Bennett, Elizabeth Bowen, Gamaliel Bradford, John Burroughs, Ivy Compton Burnett, A.E. Coppard, Baron Corvo, Cecil Day Lewis, Ronald Firbank, E.M. Forster, George Gissing, Sarah Grand, A.P. Herbert, Rudyard Kipling, Edward Lear, Matthew Gregory Lewis, Henry W. Longfellow, Amy Lowell, Leonard Merrick, John Wilmot 2nd Earl of Rochester, G.B. Shaw, J.H. Shorthouse, Edith Sitwell, and Logan Pearsall Smith.
