

Scheinfeld, Amram, 1897-

Biography: Journalist, author, professional cartoonist. Scheinfeld (1897-1979) worked as a journalist in Milwaukee, Baltimore, and New York.

Summary: Manuscripts, proofs, and printed editions of Scheinfeld's books on human heredity, *You and Heredity*, *Women and Men*, and *The New You and Heredity*. Sketches and line drawings used as illustrations in the books are included. Also, manuscripts and clippings of his magazine articles; many examples of his comic strips, including "Dixie Dugan;" and correspondence and financial documents about his works.

Organization: Selectively cataloged; remainder arranged.

Finding aids: Contents list, 4p.

Restrictions on use: Boxes 2-31 are shelved offsite and require 48 hours for access.

Available for faculty, students, and researchers engaged in scholarly or publication projects.

Permission to publish materials must be obtained in writing from the Librarian for Rare Books and Manuscripts.

There is also a collection of Amram Scheinfeld papers at the Milwaukee Public Library.
