A photostatic copy of the diary of George Templeton Strong, 1820-1875, New York lawyer and Trustee of Columbia University, who took an active role in the city's cultural and social life. The diary, running without interruption from Oct. 1835 through June 1875, contains a weath of information about life in New York City. Its scope broadens to include the national scene with the outbreak of the Civil War. There is also a miscellaneous assortment of approximately 150 photostatic copies of personal correspondence with family and friends, correspondence during his term as treasurer of the U.S. Sanitary Commission, original drawings, caricatures and doodlings, invitations, guest lists, theater and copert programs, newspaper clippings, a family tree, and photographs. Also included is a typescript copy of the diary, with an index.
