DESCRIPTION:

Printed material and some correspondence related to low rental housing and tenements in New York City. Included are business records concerning the rental and maintenance of tenements. Mr. White, a successful Brooklyn merchant, did a study of homes of the laboring classes and, in 1876, erected the first successful improved tenement homes in the country.
