DESCRIPTION:

Papers of the Gagarin family, consisting of correspondence, manuscripts, documents, invitations, drawings, and photographs. The correspondence includes letters to Prince Gagarin, Russian Ambassador in Rome in the 1820s and 1830s; letters to Prince Aleksandr A. Gagarin, who served in such official posts as Russian consul in Beirut and Barcelona around the turn of the century; and one letter each from I. I. Gilder and Fedor Shaliapin to Princess (Mariia?) Gagarina. The documents chiefly concern Prince Aleksandr A. Gagarin. There are photographs of the Emir of Bokhara and his son from about 1900.

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
