DESCRIPTION.

Memoirs of Prince Aleksandr D. Golitsyn (1874-), provincial political leader and member of the State Duma and Senate before the Revolution. The memoirs are in two series: his typescript "Vospominania" (453p. in 17 notebooks), which cover his childhood and youth, his "period of social and political service (1900-1917)", World War I, and the Revolution and Civil War; and a manuscript in two notebooks entitled "Vtoroi god Russkoj Revoliutsii: Bol'shevizm na Ukraine; Getmanskii perevorot; Petliurovshchina" (410p.), which discusses the Civil War in the Ukraine.
