## DESCRIPTION:

Manuscript and typoscript mencirs on various subjects by Mikhail A. Golubov (1843- ), an officer in Occasek units of the Imperial and White armies, who emigrated to Turkey, then Greece, and finally settled in Austria. The memoirs describe Daretov in 1917, the Crimea in 1920, refugee camps in Turkey in 1920-1, Vienna during World Mar II, the repotriation of Cossacks at Lienz in 1915, and displaced persons camps after World Mar II.
