Papers of Mikhail D. Karachevskii-Karateev (1904-1978), engineer; ~~and~~ **historical novelist** who wrote under the name M.Karateev; among his novels were Iarlyk velikogo khana and Karach-Murza. The papers include correspondence, manuscripts, and printed materials. The manuscripts include drafts of several of his novels, including the two mentioned above, and of his non-fiction works, such as Paragvaiskaia nadezhda and Belogvardeitsy na Balkanakh. Printed materials include clippings and copies of several of his books. Also in the collection are manuscripts of poems and stories, and copies of two books, by his father, Dmitrii V. Karachevskii-Karateev.
