DESCRIPTION: Papers of Vasilii F. Klement'ev (189?-), officer in the White army and member of the Soiuz Zashchity Rodiny i Svobody (League for the Defense of the Motherland and Freedom). The bulk of the papers consists of Klement'ev's manuscript memoirs (ca. 250p.), which deal with such topics as the Civil War, Boris Savinkov and the Soiuz Zashchity, and the emigration in Poland. Also included are: a letter from Gleb Struve; letters of members of the Soiuz Zashchity from the 1920s, Flegont Klepikov and Leonid Sheshenia (with a photograph of the latter); and a volume of essays on the Soviet secret police, entitled Che-Ka, published by the Russian Socialist Revolutionaries in 1922.
