DESCRIPTION: The papers of Aleksandr V. Kuksin (1888-1966), who served in the Skoropadskii government of Ukraine and later became active in anti-Communist politics in emigration. The collection includes correspondence, manuscripts, diaries (1941-1966), documents, printed materials, photographs, and appointment books (1925-1965). The bulk of the material concerns Kuksin's activities in emigration. Included is a signed copy of a treaty drawn up in 1921 among various anti-Communist political groups in Turkey, including the Ukrainian Rada and the Peasant National Party (Krest'ianskaia narodnaia partiia), pledging cooperation against the Communists. Several of the family photographs in the collection pre-date the Revolution.
