DESCRIPTION: Papers of Andrei F. Berladnik-Pukovskii (-), officer in the Russian army. The papers include: a manuscript with drawings by Berladnik-Pukovskii about his stay in Central Asia in 1911-12; a manuscript by him on the history of relations between Russia and the peoples of the northern Caucasus; documents concerning the Russian army in 1917; correspondence, documents, and related materials concerning the Union of Refugees from the Northern Caucasus (Soiuz Gortsev Bezhentsev Severnogo Kavkaza) in Constantinople in the 1920s, which Berladnik-Pukovskii headed; and printed materials. Also included is a large map of Central Asia.
