DESCRIPTION:

Correspondence, manuscripts, subject files, and printed materials of Afrikan P. Bogaevskii (1872-1934), Imperial and White army general and ataman of the Don Cossacks in 1919-34. The bulk of the collection concerns emigre Cossacks in Europe, but there are also materials from the Civil War. There are letters from from such White generals as ~~_____~~ Petr Krasnov, Aleksandr Kutepov, and Petr Wrangel, and many letters from various persons to Bogaevskii's widow after his death. Manuscripts include Bogaevskii's addresses ("obrashcheniia") to the emigre Cossacks and his memoirs about the Kuban campaign of 1918. Subject files concern the Civil War, emigre Cossack affairs, and related matters. Printed materials touch on Bogaevskii's death and funeral.
