DESCRIPTION: Papers of Nikolai A. Pal'chevskii(), a soldier in the Imperial Army who remained in France after being captured by the Germans in World War I. In emigration he was active in the Paris Turgenev Library Committee. The collection consists of correspondence, a manuscript copy of the P.O.W. journal Alibud'er in France, a subject file on the Turgenev Library, documents, picture postcards, and printed materials. Correspondence consists of letters and postcards to and from Pal'chevskii. There is one letter from Vladimir Burtsev. Documents are Pal'chevskii's and include passports and affidavits, mostly from France. Picture postcards are primarily ~~on~~ historical ^{topics} figures. Printed materials include mainly clippings and programs.
