DESCRIPTION. Manuscripts and printed materials of Innokentii S. Smolin (1884-1973), officer in the Imperial Army. The manuscripts, all of which are by Smolin, include his memoirs, "Davnominuvshee--Vospominaniia starogo ofitsera." These memoirs describe Smolin's childhood in Yakutsk, his military training, and his service in the Finliandskii Polk, the Russo-Japanese War, the 1905 Revolution and World War I. The other, more minor manuscripts primarily deal with military themes. The printed materials consist of two articles by Smolin that appeared in the emigre press.
