DESCRIPTION: Correspondence, manuscripts, documents, photographs, printed materials, and coins of Mariia A. Sviatopolk-Mirskaia (-ca. 1960?) and her son, Nikolai V. Sviatopolk-Mirskii (-). The correspondence is primarily from members of the Imperial family (such as Grand Duke Nikolai Nikolaevich and Dowager Empress Mariia Fedorovna) to Mariia Sviatopolk-Mirskaia. Most of it dates from the 1920s and 1930s and much of it is mounted in scrapbooks. The manuscripts include Basil Strandman's "Balkan Reminiscences." Among the documents are diplomas, certificates, passports and Imperial decrees dating back to 1832. The photographs include a photograph of Metropolitan Evlogii and several dozen copies of Imperial family photographs. There are also many photographs of paintings, icons and architecture. The subject files consist of materials relating to the Notbek family, the Mariinskoe Sestrichestvo (to which Mariia Sviatopolk-Mirskaia belonged), and the Iverskaia Church in Belgrade. Among the printed materials are 12 issues of Khudozhestvennyia Sokrovishcha Rossii (1901), Mémoires du regne de Catherine... (Amsterdam, 1729), and Théâtre de l'Hermitage de Catherine II... (Paris, 1799?).
