DESCRIPTION:

Manuscripts, documents, photographs and printed materials of Georgii A. Teslavskii (-), Imperial and White Army officer and writer who used the pen name Iurii Pskovitianin. Teslavskii's manuscripts include a three-volume autobiographical novel entitled "Burelom" that chiefly deals with the 1917 Revolution and the Northwestern front during the Civil War. "Vospominania" discusses Teslavskii's education, military service during World War I and the Civil War and emigration to Argentina. Among the documents is a certificate issued to Teslavskii's grandfather during the reign of Aleksandr II. There are four photographs of Teslavskii, a few caricatures of Russian army officers and members of the Semenov chorus in Warsaw, 1943, and copies of Seiatel' and Smena, periodicals published by the emigre community in Buenos Aires.
