DESCRIPTION:

A letter, manuscripts, photographs, and printed materials of members of the Sozonovich family, specifically Ivan Petrovich (1856-1923), a professor of literature at the Russian University in Warsaw; his wife Ol'ga Petrovna (1867-1951); their daughter Mariia Sozonovich-Kozhina (-); and their son Petr (-1920). The letter is by Vladimir Frantsev. Manuscripts consist of lectures by Ivan Sozonovich and poems by his wife. There are photographs of the Sozonovich family; of Konstantin Bestuzhev-Riumin, founder of a program of higher education for women in St. Petersburg; and of several professors at Warsaw University -- Vladimir Frantsev, Konstantin Grot, and Ivan Filevich. Printed materials include periodicals with items by Mariia Sozonovich-Kozhina.
