DESCRIPTION: Papers of Mikhail K. Borel' (-1979) and his wife, Vera M. (-), the daughter of General Mikhail V. Alekseev (1857-1918). The collection includes correspondence and manuscripts, as well as a few copies of documents. The correspondence of General Alekseev, a principal commander of the White armies during the Civil War, is represented by extracts from letters of the period of the Russo-Japanese War (1905-1906), and by copies of both official and personal correspondence from 1917-1918. Also included are a few letters to K. V. Denikina answering requests for information about General Alekseev; these include 2 from his daughter V. M. Borel'. The largest part of the collection comprises manuscripts by M. K. Borel': a lengthy memoir of the Civil War entitled "Za veru i vernost'", other Civil War memoirs, and a number of brief historical anecdotes and stories of late Imperial and Revolutionary Russia. A Russian translation by M. K. Borel' of an account of the battle of Mukden by a British journalist named Atteridge and a memoir of 1917 by Sergei Novikov called "Konets rodnogo polka" complete the collection.
