DESCRIPTION:

Papers of Avraham Yarmolinsky, i.e. Abram Iarmolinskii (1890-1975), Ph.D. 1921, head of the Slavonic Division of New York Public Library from 1918 to 1955, and author, editor, and translator of numerous books in the field of Russian literature. The collection consists primarily of correspondence and manuscripts. There are letters from Kornei Chukovskii, Mikhail Karpovich, Andre Mazon, Vladimir Nabokov, and Evgenii Zamiatin; and one item each from Serrei Esenin, Pavel Miliukov, Ivan Pavlov, and Nikolai Roerich. Manuscripts include photocopies of poems by Kornei Chukovskii, Serrei Esenin, and Boris Pasternak. There are subject files on Dostoevskii, Turgenev, Soviet education, and Slavic studies in the United States, and a photograph of Isaak Babel' with his daughter.
